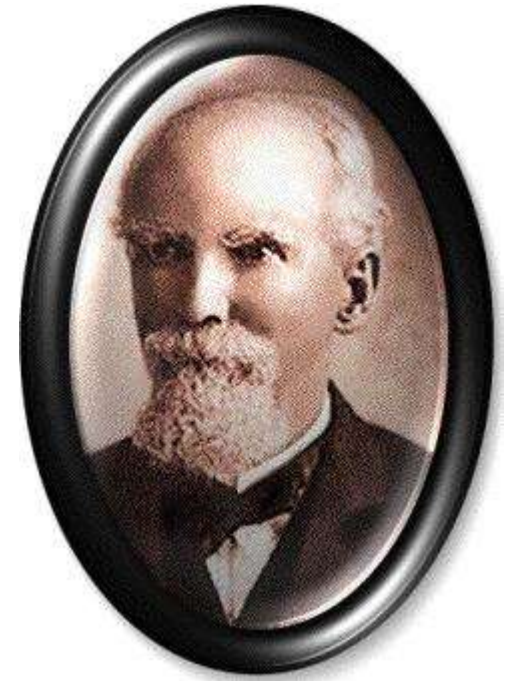

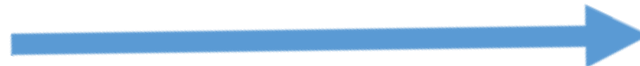

Confession

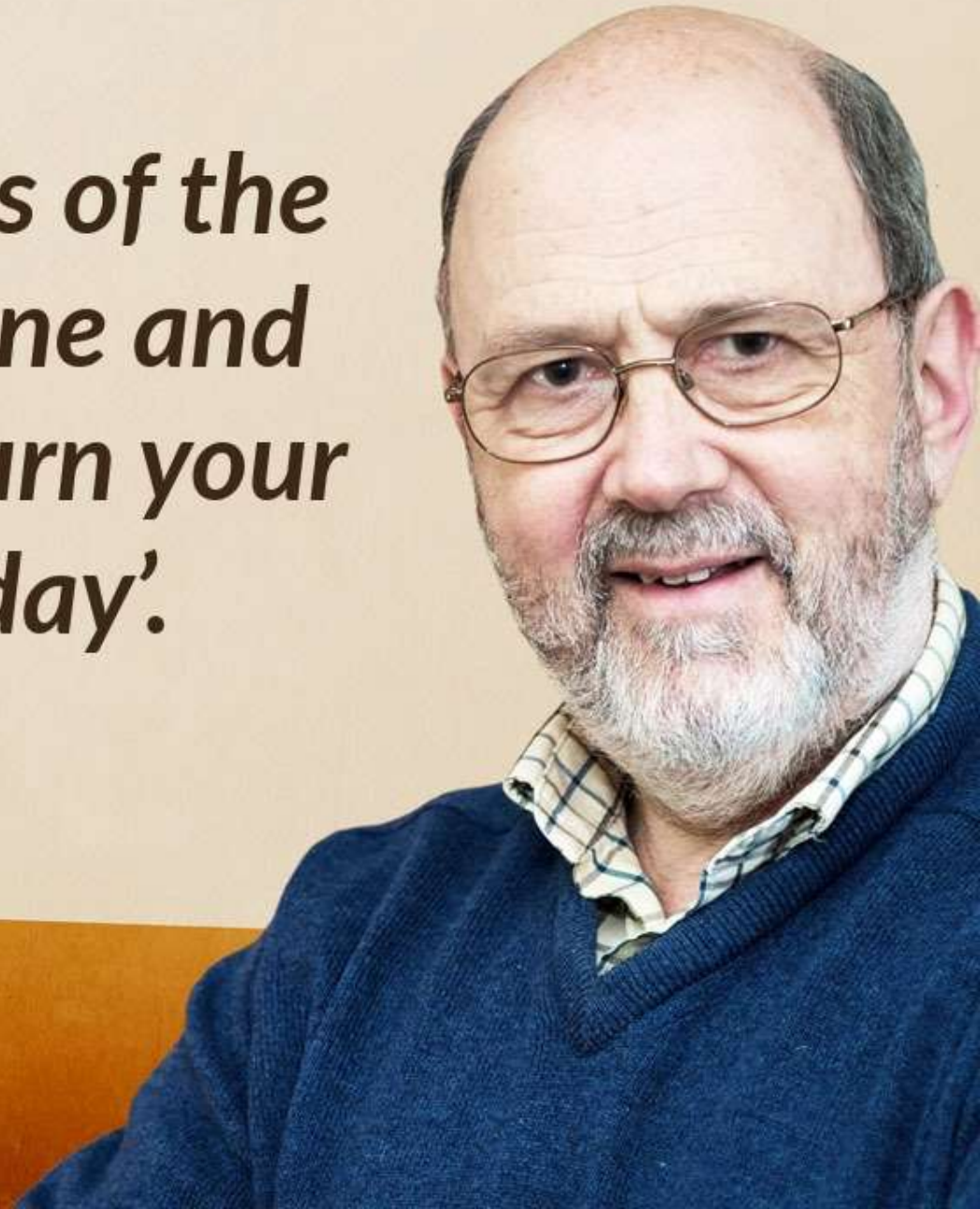
God is wise in heart and mighty in strength.
